Gray cashmere jersey.

Description

Dress constructed from a single trapezoidal panel of jersey, folded in half to create a long, fitted tunic that reaches the floor. The fabric envelops the body like a kind of mantle.

The garment features seams along the left side and shoulders. Sleeves are long and set-in, and the collar is high and closely fitted. At the back, a round keyhole opening interrupts the continuity of the back. The fastening system includes two zippers: one along the left side seam, the other running along the collar and left shoulder, reinforced with a rigid boning element.

At knee height, a slit allows the fabric to be folded upward and partially secured at the shoulders. This generates a mantle effect that falls freely from the left shoulder to the floor, forming a train. The side of the train stitched to the shoulder measures approximately 285 cm.

Remarks

Ferré chooses jersey, an elastic material that allows for a close fit and natural draping without the need for cuts. It folds over itself with extreme softness and gracefully follows the movement of the body.
