Materials

Black stretch tulle; nude-colored tulle; forest green and wood brown raffia; forest green and gold bugle beads; black plastic applications; whalebones.

Working processes

Hand-machine embroidery; applications.

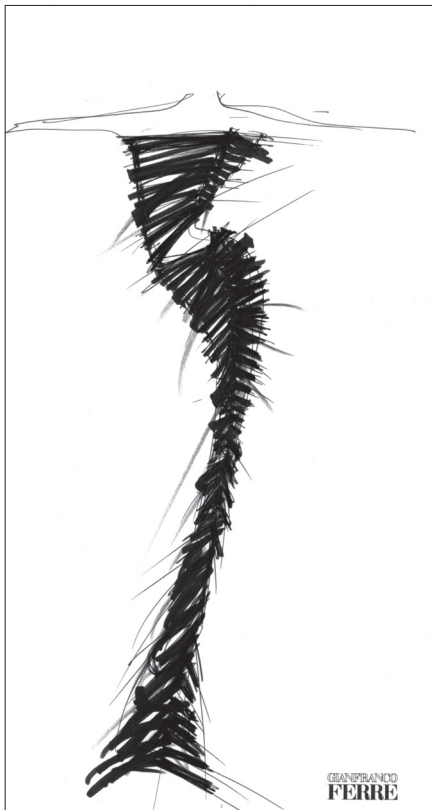
Description

Bustier dress, fitted and ankle-length. On the stretch tulle base, ribbons in various shades of raffia are irregularly applied with a running stitch, which in some points reveal the tulle. Embroideries in bugle beads and black plastic are added, seeming to wrap around and secure the raffia. On both sides and at the back of the garment, the raffia threads, left loose, form irregular vertical sequences of fringes of different lengths.

Remarks

In a search for a new kind of glamour, Ferré steps into an imaginary garden — where this luminous, grass-like gown comes to life.
