

Curricular Paper B

Checklist

Compulsory:

- Does **the cover** include the title, any subtitle, contextual information (e.g., university name and logo, school, course of study, academic year, name and surname of the candidate with matriculation number), and a significant and pertinent image?
- Does the paper include a short **abstract** of approximately 2,000 characters, that highlights the choice of the topic and the definition of the research question?
- Is the paper structured through an **index with summaries**, which highlight the connections between the parts of the thesis, and the relevance of the selected projects and studies in relation to the research theme and question?
- Does the thesis include a **critical text** of approximately 15-20,000 characters, that highlights the proposed topic as a reading key of the design experiences within the three-year course of study, by explaining the main architectural, design, and bibliographic references adopted?
- Are the **A3 pages** included **between a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 15 pages**?
- In the **A3 pages**, are the cases (selected among the studios and courses attended in the three-year course of study) included **between a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 projects and studies**?
- Are the **A3 pages** the result of an **original re-elaboration**?
- In the **A3 pages**, are the **references to the teachers and members of the working groups** of the attended studios and courses correctly reported?
- Does the paper comply with **anti-plagiarism rules**?
- Are the **citations** in the text compliant with the editorial norms?
- Are the **sources of the images** compliant with the editorial norms?
- Does the **final list of the sources** comply with the editorial norms?

Optional:

- Is the thesis structured through an analytical approach or through a design approach?
- Is the thesis structured through a mono-disciplinary approach or through a trans-scalar approach?
